Now that the Meeting House is open, collections can also be made in person.

Special Collections

The **Special Collection** on 24 November is Money for Madagascar (MfM) and will be introduced by Neil McKechnie.

Donations to MfM between midday Tuesday 3 December and Tuesday 10 December will be doubled twice by other funders. For example, MfM will receive £40 from a £10 donation.

MfM is a charity launched by Welsh Quakers in 1986 to support Malagasy solutions to Malagasy problems.

Staying true to its original values it is strengthening its capacity to do good and its commitment to locally led development and conservation.

- A new 10 year strategy with a registration makes it accountable to both the UK and Malagasy governments.
- A new collaboration with **Solar United Madagascar consortium** will use solar power to develop health and education projects. With a focus on improving

educational outcomes, 80 schools are in the pilot phase and there is potential for large scale roll-out of off grid energy reaching rural areas across Madagascar.

 A new CEO is a Malagasy woman with 20 years experience in conservation and development.

During COP 26 our B&B scheme hosted three delegates from SAF, a Malagasy Non Governmental Organisation (NGO) which works with MfM. Many Glasgow Friends met them and were touched to hear first-hand the environmental and political challenges they faced and inspired by their long-standing commitment to their people.

MfM asks for donations between **noon on Tuesday 3 December and Tuesday 10th December** via their Big Give Christmas Challenge. These donations will be doubled by the Big Give and then doubled by a Foundation that is committed to support MfM's Education for Life programme.

All funds go to activities in Madagascar. 70% of the population live in poverty exacerbated by climate extremes. At a time of widespread worrying news, this campaign is a chance to deliver something really positive: greater empowerment of Malagasy communities to tackle very real, very serious, challenges of climate catastrophe and poverty, and improve lives, health and prospects.

A target of £30,000 in donations would mean £120,000 becomes available to give 3,000 children in 10 remote communities the chance to access a life-changing education.

Once the £30,000 target is reached and outwith these dates donations will go to this appeal but will not be doubled on the Big Give site.

Donations collected after Meeting on Sunday 24th by Neil McKechnie will form a bulk donation from Glasgow Quaker Meeting.

The **December collection** will be for a charity chosen by the Children's Meeting.
