











100 years ago – The Battle of Jutland

8,500 lives were lost in the battle of Jutland, the biggest naval battle of WW1, which took place in the North Sea towards the coasts of Norway and Denmark. 6,000 deaths were from the British fleet, which sailed from Orkney, the Moray Firth and the Firth of Forth on May 30-31.
